Our Camp Day runs from **9:00 am - 3:00pm**. Earlier drop off begins at 8:15am. **Extended Camp Day Services** are available upon request for an additional of \$10 daily (\$5am/ \$5pm) or \$45 weekly)

GENERAL INFORMATION

Upon arrival and collection of campers, parents/guardians are asked to **note their times of arrival and collection followed by their signatures** in our camp log book.


Please **inform the Camp Director/Team Members** if someone other than listed contacts will be collecting your camper. The name of the individual and contact information should also be submitted.

Ensure that all personal items of your camper are clearly labelled with first and last names.

Dress your camper in appropriate comfortable clothing and footwear.

Pack light lunches and healthy snack options for the duration of your camper's day. As the summer heat approaches, please ensure that your camper has their water bottles. Refills happen throughout the day.

BEHAVIOURAL EXPECTATIONS

Here at  our camp rules are rooted in safety and respect for each other. All rules will be reviewed daily at camp, but we ask that you review these with your child(ren) at home as well.

- Listen carefully and respectfully to camp authority.
- Follow all rules and instructions of Camp Staff.
- Keep hands and feet to one's self
- Use age appropriate language
- Always practice using good manners.
- Respect others feelings and differences.
- Practice taking turns



BEHAVIOURAL EXPECTATIONS

Children will be made aware of the rules and guidelines for their behaviour and the consequences for disobeying them.

1. **First Incident** - Verbal Warning: camper will be given an explanation on why their behavior was deemed inappropriate.
2. **Second Incident** - Time Out: If the behaviour continues campers will be given a time out. Parents/guardian will be emailed a detailed note about the behaviour.
3. **Third Incident** - Children who are continually disruptive to the running of the program, parents/guardians will be contacted immediately for their prompt collection.
